

(16 mm., 9.5 mm. & 8mm.)

Specification

This Joiner has been specially designed for 16mm., 9.5 mm. and 8mm. film stock, for the efficient splicing of which a joiner is essential.

It makes a 3/32" full sprocket hole precision join on any film in under two minutes from the start to completion of the operation, allowing the necessary time for the film cement to harden.

The specially manufactured serrated Scraper is so designed that not only is the emulsion and part of the film base itself removed by a dry scrape; but furthermore, the base is left slightly grooved to ensure permanent 'weld' to the joined edges—an essential to joining on safety films.

The Rotary Cutter ensures a clean and perfect cut in one simple movement.

Both the Scraper and Cutter are combined in a single unit which is simplicity itself to handle (a patent has been applied for in respect of this device in conjunction with the Joiner).

The 'scraping to cutting' position is achieved by one simple movement of the centre pressure bar.

This centre bar is spring loaded to ensure pressure being automatically applied over the join after the film cement has been applied.

The Joiner is kept rigid on any surface by means of rubber feet fitted to the four corners of the base, or may be screwed down through the countersunk holes provided.

All working parts are attractively finished in nickel and dull chrome; all castings being finished in grey. It is most moderate in cost being only:
