

SIMPLE TO OPERATE:

Plenty of finger room for threading and servicing—notice the big opening of the film gate.

Automatic loop setting—no more short loops.

Spot sight aperture in the shutter guard—full

Framing, focussing, and shutter timing knobs all in the front of the mechanism.

ACCESSIBLE AND EASY TO MAINTAIN:

Main drive shaft, vertical shaft, and shutter shaft are all removable as complete units.


All shaft assemblies are interchangeable with minimum loss of time.

Gate easily removable for cleaning and inspection.

Film trap shoes interchangeable and reversible. Intermittent oil cup and gauge are on operating side of mechanism.

Full width doors leave plenty of working space round all units.


